TREASURER'S REPORT

As of July 27, 2007 the financial status of the club is as follows:

Previous balance (6/27/07)	\$4391.03
Expenditures (since 6/27/07)	\$505.04
Total Income (since 6/27/07)	\$30.00
Ending Balance	\$3915.99

Expenditures were \$405.04 for four months of sanitation payments (they never changed the billing address so I never got the bills) at the field, and \$100.00 for cutting the field once. Income was \$30.00 in club membership renewals.

Reminder, all club dues for 2007 are now late. Dues for 2007 are \$50 for regular membership, and \$10 for a junior (under 19 years of age) membership.
