Expenditures included \$191.84 for sanitation at the field, and \$100.00 reimbursed for Christmas party expenses. Income was \$900.00 in club memberships.

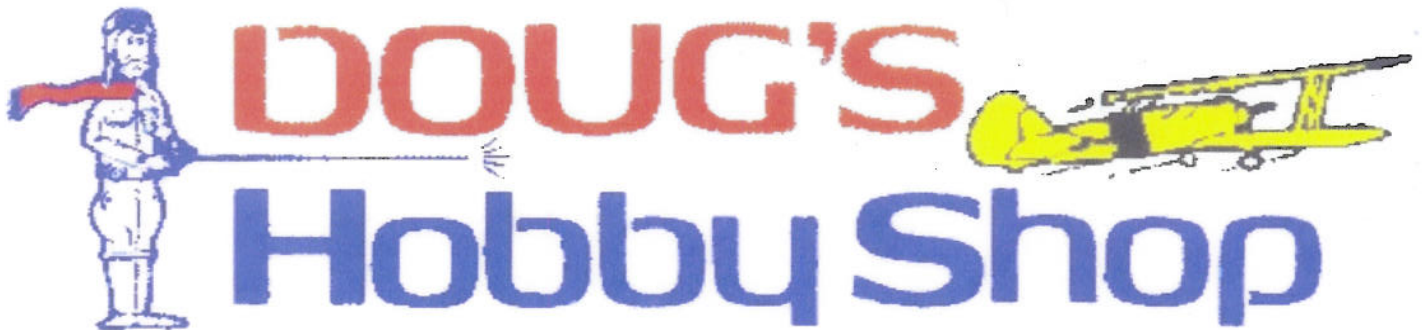
