# TREASURER'S REPORT

As of June 27, 2007 the financial status of the club is as follows:

Previous balance (4/27/07)	\$7563.14
Expenditures (since 4/27/07)	\$3482.11
<b>Total Income (since 4/27/07)</b>	<b>\$310.00</b>
<b>Ending Balance</b>	<b>\$4391.03</b>

Expenditures were \$160.00 for AMA charter renewal, \$98.79 for sanitation at the field, and \$3023.32 for all of the prep work and materials for the new runway. Income was \$310.00 in club membership renewals.

Reminder, all club dues for 2007 are now late. Dues for 2007 are \$50 for regular membership, and \$10 for a junior (under 19 years of age) membership. All dues payments should now include a \$20 late fee. Proof of a current AMA membership is also required at the time of renewal.
