

Treasurer's Report

As of February 27, 2006 the financial status of the club is as follows:

Previous balance (1/26/06) \$5,649.63

Expenditures (since 1/26/06) \$95.92

Total Income (since 1/26/05) \$870.00

Ending Balance \$6423.71

Expenditures included \$95.92 for sanitation at the field. Income was \$870.00 in membership dues.

Reminder, all club dues for 2006 that have not been paid are now considered late. All dues payments should now include a \$20.00 late fee. Dues for 2006 are \$50 for regular membership, and \$10 for a junior (under 19 years of age) membership. Proof of a current AMA membership is also required at the time of renewal.
